

## **Kattetekop list of treats**

### **Fruits and vegetables**

- Skewer with fruit such as mandarins, strawberries, melon squares and/or mango.
- Skewer with two strawberries and two pineapple squares.
- Skewer with small pickle, piece of cucumber, square of melon, pineapple or mango, mandarin pieces.
- Mandarin with a parasol.
- Fruit in colored cups with a paper umbrella.
- *Zonnatura* fruit bars.
- Skewers with pieces of fruit: stick the skewers into half a cabbage wrapped in aluminum foil and hand them out.
- Decorating bananas by drawing on faces with a marker.
- Making a sailing boat from bananas with a skewer and a piece of paper.
- Baby cucumbers other chopped raw vegetables.

### **Decorated fruit**

- *Mandarin cat*  
Use the mandarin stalk as a nose. Stick in two almonds for the ears; use cocktails sticks as whiskers and two small raisins for the eyes. You can also cut off the base so that the cats can stand more easily.
- *Orange elephant*  
Use small oranges. Cut out the trunk from the peel and let it hang loose from the pulp. Use two raisins to make the eyes. You can also cut off the base so that the elephants stand more easily.
- *Maya the Bee*  
Use a black marker to draw a face on a mandarin and stick in two cocktail sticks for antennas.
- A piece of melon or cucumber with a paper umbrella.
- Fold a large sheet of colored paper into a cone and fill it with mandarins.

### **Salty snacks**

- Pom-bears (low salt content).

### **Savoury snacks**

- Fold paper squares into the shape of a French fries cone and fill it with strips of cheese, carrot and cucumber.

### **Cakes and pancakes**

- Pancake roll.  
Thinly spread pancakes with apple syrup or honey and roll them up. Cut the rolled pancakes into small rolls. Fix the rolls with an umbrella, flag or other cocktail stick.
- Thread 1 or 2 pancake rolls onto a cocktail stick with a strawberry.

**Other ideas**

- Mini raisin bun, possibly with a pretty cocktail stick, umbrella or flag.
- Festini pear or strawberry popsicles.

**Gifts**

- Wrap small raisin boxes or little gifts in wrapping paper. Attach ribbon and hang the gifts on an open umbrella.
- Small gifts in a bag or a piece of cellophane with a bow.
- Bread stick with a toy.
- 3 blackboard or sidewalk chalks tied together with a bow.
- Slip finger puppets on bread sticks and place them on a plate.
- Lucky dip. Decorate a box; fill it with small wrapped gifts such as stickers, chalks, finger puppets, etc. Fill the box with newspapers or bits of paper and the children can dip into the box to find a gift.!
- A group gift (children's book).
- Pencil/sand mould/chalk, etc. in a pretty wrapping.
